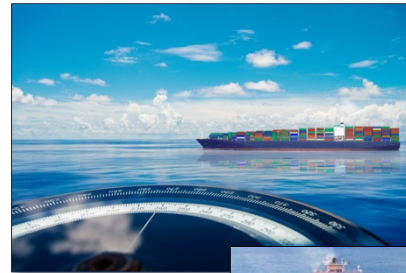




## Purchasing Supervisor (m/f/d) Shipping Company, Hamburg
